

Substitute Art Lesson Plan

Grade(s): all Title: Paper Strip Sculpture

Overall objective(s)/essential(s)/SOL(s) covered in this lesson:

- Children will be introduced to the word SCULPTURE
 - Children will have opportunity to explore new and old means of manipulating paper
- VOCAB: fold, twist, fan-fold, curl, 3-dimensional, sculpture

Supplies:

<u> </u> markers	<u> </u> 9x12	white paper
<u> √</u> glue	<u> </u> 12x18	white paper
<u> √</u> scissors	<u> </u> _____	white paper
<u> √</u> crayons	<u> √</u> 11x7	<u>poster board</u>
<u> </u> pencils/erasers		
<u> √</u> <u>other:</u> <u>strips of construction paper (black & white, or colors),</u> <u>about 1/2" x 9", but other sizes will do as well</u>		

Motivation/Procedure: √ see back/attached paper also

Show children a painting and a statue:

“Does anyone know what a sculpture is?” *statues, stick out, 3-dimensional*

“How is a sculpture different from a painting?” *flat, 2-dimensional*

“We’re going to make a **sculpture** today. It will not look like a person or an object—it will be made of lines! (Using strips of paper)”

“A sculpture usually has a base, and the poster board will be the base for your sculpture.”

“Lines are 2-dimensional (flat), but if we twist, bend, fold, curl, and roll the strips of paper, and glue them down, they become 3-dimensional. Why?”

Because they will stick up, or out

DEMONSTRATE HOW TO MANIPULATE STRIPS and glue down. (see back page)

“So we are building a sculpture with lines. This does not have to look like anything, but it may remind you of a playground, or a racetrack. The most important thing is how the lines! When you turn your sculpture around, it will look different from each side. You can even put shapes inside other shapes, or connect one piece to another.”

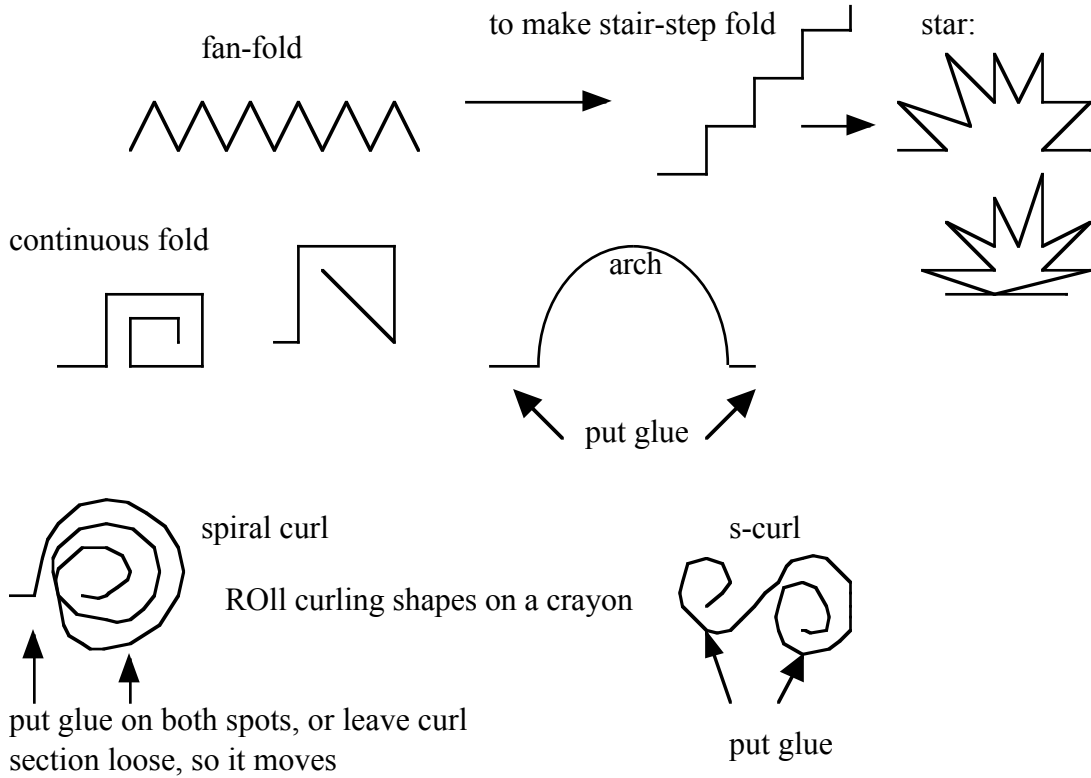
